

**GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**  
**dated March 14, 2022 No. 362, MOSCOW**

**On the introduction of a temporary ban on the export of grain crops  
outside the territory of the Russian Federation**

In accordance with Articles 29 and 47 of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union dated May 29, 2014, Appendix No. 7 to the above of the Agreement, Clause 1 of Part 2 of Article 21 of the Federal Law "On the Fundamentals state regulation of foreign trade activities" and for the purposes of ensuring food security The Government of the Russian Federation decides:

1. Install from March 15 to June 30, 2022 inclusive temporary ban on the export of wheat and meslin from the Russian Federation (group 1001 TN VED EAEU), rye (group 1002 TN VED EAEU), barley (group 1003 TN VED EAEU) and corn (group 1005 TN VED EAEU) (hereinafter referred to as grain crops).

2. The temporary ban does not apply:

a) on grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation for International Humanitarian Aid to foreign states on the basis of decisions of the Government Russian Federation;

b) on grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federations within the framework of international transit traffic, beginning and ending outside the territory of the Russian Federation, as well as on grain crops of the Russian Federation, moved between parts of the territory of the Russian Federation through territories of foreign states;

c) on grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation as supplies;

d) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation in order to ensure the activities of military units Russian Federation, located in the territories of foreign states;

e) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation in order to ensure the activities of organizations of the Russian Federation located in Baikonur (Republic of Kazakhstan) and on the territory of the Baikonur complex;

f) on grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation in order to ensure the activities of organizations of the Russian Federations in the Svalbard archipelago;

g) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federations issued in accordance with customs procedures, allowing the export of grain crops from the territory of the Russian Federation, until March 15, 2022, except for cereals, customs declaration of which was carried out with features, provided for in Articles 115 and 116 of the Customs Code Eurasian Economic Union, or with features, established by the legislation of the Member States of the Eurasian economic union on customs regulation in accordance with paragraph 8 of Article 104 of the Customs Code of the Eurasian economic union;

h) on grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation to the Republic of Abkhazia, the Republic of South Ossetia, Donetsk People's Republic and Lugansk People's Republic;

i) for grain crops in the course of transit international air transportation through the territory of the Russian Federation to third countries in the following cases:

- the aircraft is making an intermediate landing at the international airport of the Russian Federation without unloading grain crops and after intermediate planting follows beyond the territory of the Russian Federation;
- the aircraft is making an intermediate landing at the international airport of the Russian Federation with a single trans-shipment of grain crops to another aircraft following limits of the territory of the Russian Federation (without placing them under customs procedure of customs transit), provided that grain crops are under customs control and do not leave the point passes through the state border of the Russian Federation;

j) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation on the basis of one-time export licenses issued by Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation in accordance with paragraph 7 of the Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation of December 31, 2021 No. 2595 "On measures to regulate export of wheat and meslin, barley, rye and corn outside territory of the Russian Federation to states that are not members Eurasian Economic Union";

k) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation for use by passengers and crew of watercraft, aircraft or train passengers and train workers brigades, drivers of motor vehicles, carrying out international transportation, as well as to ensure activities of watercraft, structures and installations, in relation to which the Russian Federation has exclusive jurisdiction;

l) for grain crops exported from the territory of the Russian Federation to the Republic of Belarus within the framework of the Union State.

3. Federal Customs Service, Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Supervision, Border Guard Service Federal Services Security Council of the Russian Federation, to the Ministry Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation and the Federal Troops Service National Guard of the Russian Federation within the competence ensure control over the implementation of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this resolutions.

4. To the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation in notify the Eurasian Economic Commission in accordance with the established procedure on the introduction of a temporary ban specified in paragraph 1 of this resolutions.

5. This resolution comes into force on March 15, 2022.
