On the introduction of a temporary ban on export Russian Federation of medical devices, previously imported into the Russian Federation from the territory foreign states that have decided to introduce restrictive measures against the Russian Federation economic nature

The Government of the Russian Federation decides:

1. Establish a temporary ban on export from the Russian Federation medical devices manufactured in foreign countries states that have decided to introduce in respect of the Russian Federation of Restrictive Economic Measures and previously imported into the Russian Federation from the territory of such foreign countries, except for the export of such products for providing international humanitarian assistance to foreign states on the basis of decisions of the Government of the Russian Federation, as well as the export of these products by individuals for personal use (hereinafter referred to as temporary prohibition). The temporary ban also applies to goods that placed under customs procedures prior to the entry into force of this decisions and the actual export of which from the customs territory Russian Federation in accordance with these customs procedures will be carried out after the entry into force of this resolution.
2. The temporary ban does not apply to the export of goods for the purpose of:
 - movements within the framework of international transit traffic,
 - beginning and ending outside the territory of the Russian Federation, as well as goods of the Russian Federation moved between parts of the territory of the Russian Federation through the territories foreign states;
 - ensuring the activities of military formations of the Russian Federations located on the territory of foreign states;
 - ensuring the activities of organizations of the Russian Federation, located in Baikonur (Republic of Kazakhstan) and on the territory complex "Baikonur";
 - ensuring the activities of organizations of the Russian Federation on the Svalbard archipelago.
3. The Federal Customs Service to ensure control over fulfilment of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this resolution.
4. To the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation, Border Service of the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation and the Federal Service of the National Guard Troops the Russian Federation to provide within its competence assistance to the Federal Customs Service in the execution measures provided for by this resolution.
5. To the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation bring to the Federal Customs Service a list of foreign states that have decided to introduce in respect of the Russian Federation of restrictive economic measures.
6. Federal Service for Surveillance in Healthcare inform suppliers of medical devices about the temporary ban.
7. This Resolution shall enter into force on the day of its official publication and is valid until December 31, 2022.
