

GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

On measures to implement the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation
dated March 8, 2022 No. 100

In pursuance of subparagraph "a" of paragraph 1 and paragraph 4 of the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation dated March 8, 2022 No. 100 "On the use for the purposes ensuring the security of the Russian Federation of special economic measures in the field of foreign economic activity" The Government of the Russian Federation decides:

1. Introduce an export ban until December 31, 2022 inclusive outside the territory of the Russian Federation to foreign countries and territories according to the list in accordance with Appendix No. 1 of certain types of goods according to the list in accordance with Appendix No. 2.
2. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 1 of this regulation, does not apply:
 - for goods exported from the territory of the Russian Federation under international transit traffic starting and ending outside the territory of the Russian Federation, as well as for goods originating from the territory of the Russian Federation, moved between parts of the territory of the Russian Federation through territories of foreign states;
 - on goods exported from the territory of the Russian Federation for the purpose of ensuring the activities of military formations of the Russian Federations located on the territories of foreign states;
 - on goods exported from the territory of the Russian Federation for the purpose of ensuring the activities of organizations of the Russian Federation in the Svalbard archipelago;on goods exported by individuals for personal use.
3. Federal customs service to ensure control for the implementation of the provisions of paragraph 1 of this resolution.
4. To the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation, Border Service of the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation and the Federal Service of the National Guard Troops the Russian Federation to provide within its competence assistance to the Federal Customs Service in carrying out appropriate control measures.
5. This resolution shall enter into force on the day of its official publication.
